# Grooming Guidelines

At Six Flags Magic Mountain, we believe that maintaining a professional appearance is important for representing our brand and creating a positive work environment. As such, we have established grooming guidelines to ensure that all employees present themselves in a manner that is clean, neat, and appropriate for the workplace.

- **ID CARDS** – Unless notified to the contrary, team member IDs must be visible whenever you are on Six Flags property.
- **PIERCINGS, BODY MODIFICATIONS** – No visible piercings, other than earrings, a single nose stud, or a single small nose ring are permitted. Only one nostril can be pierced. Gauges are not permitted. Visible, intentional body modifications that create a distracting or unprofessional appearance are not permitted. This includes, but is not limited to dental grills, tongue splitting, tooth filling, disfiguring skin or bone implants.
- **HYGIENE** – A daily shower, the use of deodorant/antiperspirant, and brushing your teeth daily are required due to close contact with guests and coworkers. Perfumes and colognes should be limited.
- **HATS, VISORS, SCARVES** – must be worn with the bill facing forward, in the middle of your forehead, and parallel to the ground. Only Six Flags and DC branded may be worn in place of approved uniform hat. Scarves are not permitted unless part of an approved uniform.
- **HOODIES** – As the weather turns colder, we wanted to remind all employees that our grooming guidelines prohibits the use of hoodies, even if the hood is tucked in. While we understand that hoodies can be a comfortable choice for some, they do not fit the professional standards we expect of our employees.
- **SUNGLASSES** – only allowed for employees working outside. Must not be mirrored and complement your dress or uniform.

# Lost and Found

Have any guests reported losing items during their visit to the park? If so, it's important to know our lost and found procedures so we can assist them promptly. If a guest or another team member finds a lost item, it's likely been turned in to our Guest Relations team. Items left on rides are also collected by our team members at the end of each operating day. Clothing items are stored in Lost and Found for up to seven days, while valuables like electronics, wallets, keys, and IDs are kept for up to 30 days.



To help guests file a lost and found report, direct them to [Chargeback.com](https://www.chargeback.com) or the provided QR code. Encourage them to provide detailed information such as the color and design of the lost item and where it was last seen. For lost cell phones, guests should provide the IMEI number, service provider, case details, phone design, and screensaver/lock screen. If they don't have the IMEI number, they can contact their carrier to obtain it. Once the report is submitted, guests will receive a property ID number for reference. If their item is found, they'll receive an email notification from our Lost and Found team via Chargeback. Guests can also visit Guest Relations for assistance.

Additionally, please note that when assisting guests with lost item inquiries, it's **important** not to promise the guest that you will personally retrieve their item. Instead, inform them that all items found will be dropped off to the Guest Relations Lost and Found team. It's crucial that all team members are familiar with these procedures to provide the best possible service to our guests.

# Safety and Accessibility

The Six Flags Attraction Access Program (AAP) is specifically designed to accommodate guests with disabilities or certain qualifying impairments, ensuring they can enjoy our park. Each attraction has been carefully assessed to determine the necessary safety criteria for individuals to ride securely. At Six Flags, we are committed to providing a fun and accessible experience for everyone.

Guests with cognitive disorders, disabilities, or mobility impairments who require assistance can obtain the IBCCES Individual Accessibility Card (IAC) by registering at [www.accessibilitycard.org](https://www.accessibilitycard.org). Upon completing the online application and providing necessary documentation, guests will receive their digital Accessibility Card. This card should be presented at the Ride Information Center (Guest Services) within the park to request any required accommodations.

Also, we offer a Supplemental Restraint Harness (SRH "Harness") which is a full-body fall protection harness adapted to allow some riders without full extremities to experience the specified ride. Certain qualifications are required. Please direct the guest to their preferred ride for further information.

While at the Ride Information Center, guests can also rent Single/Double strollers, wheelchairs, or ECVs (while supplies last) as needed.
